Diocesan Choir Camp is sponsored by the Episcopal Diocese of New Jersey and the Church of the Advent, Cape May. The camp takes place in beautiful Cape May, and focuses on choral music, community building, and mutually supportive Christian fellowship.

Choristers of all skill levels return annually and stay in the historic Holiday House, run by the Girl's Friendly Society of the Episcopal Diocese of Pennsylvania. During their stay, the camp choristers receive individualized attention in a dynamic, creative, structured, and hands-on setting from caring teachers who are accomplished professionals in their areas of instruction.

Free time includes excursions to the Cape May Mall and boardwalk, trips to the beach, a scavenger hunt and more. The week concludes with choral Evensong attended by family, friends, and the greater community.
